



Reminder: Required Vaccination Data Reporting

From: The New Mexico Department of Health and the New Mexico Aging and Long-Term Services Department
Re: Required reporting of weekly vaccination totals for all staff and residents
To Whom It May Concern,

To: All State Licensed Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities

All congregate care facilities must comply with the Public Health Order dated December 2nd, 2021 ("Order"; "Public Health Order"), which requires all congregate care facility workers in the state of New Mexico to be up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccines unless they qualify for an exemption.

Further, pursuant to page one (1) of the "Revised Letter of Direction for Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities", updated December 14, 2021, all licensed nursing homes and assisted living facilities must report their weekly vaccination totals every Monday by 5:00 pm using the state-designated survey link https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/JH392TC.

Failure to comply with this requirement may result in civil administrative penalties available at law. Thank you for your attention to this urgent matter.
