- 209 Total Cases
 - 135 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 3 – 87 Median age: 47
 - 74 Neuroinvasive disease
 - Age range: 4 – 93 Median age: 53.5
 - 103 male, 106 female
 - 4 fatal cases, age range 76 – 88

West Nile Virus Human Case Demographics New Mexico, 2004

- 88 Total Cases
 - 53 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 12 – 85 Median age: 51
 - 31 Neuroinvasive disease
 - Age range: 16 – 84 Median age: 62
 - 4 “other” clinical syndrome
 - Age range: 2 – 59
 - 45 male, 43 female
 - 4 fatal cases, age range 68 – 82

West Nile Virus Human Case Demographics New Mexico, 2005

- 33 Total cases
 - 13 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 22 – 66 Median age: 56
 - 20 Neuroinvasive
 - Age range: 21 – 78 Median age: 48.5
 - 21 male, 12 female
 - 2 fatal cases, aged 50 and 78 years

West Nile Virus Human Case Demographics New Mexico, 2006

- 8 Total cases
 - 5 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 6 - 53 Median age: 34
 - 3 Neuroinvasive disease
 - Age range: 43 - 71 Median age: 49
 - 5 male, 3 female
 - 1 fatal case, aged 71

West Nile Virus Human Case Demographics New Mexico, 2007

- 60 Total cases
 - 21 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 3 – 72 Median age: 46
 - 39 Neuroinvasive disease
 - Age range: 11 – 90 Median age: 65
 - 33 male, 27 female
 - 3 fatal cases, age range 57 – 80

 - 3 Uncomplicated fever
 - Age range: 27 – 57 Median age: 55
 - 5 Neuroinvasive disease
 - Age range: 48 – 80 Median age: 64
