

New Mexico Department of Health 2019 Weekly Infectious Disease Report Week 33 August 11, 2019 - August 17, 2019

NM-EDSS is a web-based system used by public health staff throughout the state to track investigations of suspected, probable and confirmed cases of notifiable infectious diseases. 
Monthly Trends for Selected Notifiable Infectious Diseases As of August 17, 2019




Number of Reported Cases of Campylobacteriosis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Giardiasis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Pertussis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Salmonellosis by Month
