

New Mexico Department of Health 2017 Weekly Infectious Disease Report Week 26 June 25, 2017 - July 01, 2017

NM-EDSS is a web-based system used by public health staff throughout the state to track investigations of suspected, probable and confirmed cases of notifiable infectious diseases. Data for the current year are provisional and subject to change upon the completion of ongoing disease investigations. Data for prior years are also subject to minor revisions due to corrections or identification of historical cases. 










Number of Reported Cases of Pertussis by Month





Number of Reported Cases of Salmonellosis by Month


Number of Reported Cases of Shiga toxin-producing E. coli by Month
