

# New Mexico Department of Health 2018 Weekly Infectious Disease Report Week 22 May 27, 2018 - June 2, 2018

This report is prepared by the Epidemiology and Response Division (ERD) Infectious Disease Epidemiology Bureau (IDEB) for notifiable infectious diseases reported through the New Mexico Electronic Disease Surveillance Systems (NM-EDSS). NM-EDSS is a web-based system used by public health staff throughout the state to track investigations of suspected, probable and confirmed cases of notifiable infectious diseases. Data for the current year are provisional and subject to change upon the completion of ongoing disease investigations. Data for prior years are also subject to minor revisions due to corrections or identification of historical cases. 
### Monthly Trends for Selected Notifiable Infectious Diseases As of June 2, 2018


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#### Number of Reported Cases of Campylobacteriosis by Month


#### Number of Reported Cases of Salmonellosis by Month










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






Number of Reported Cases of Pertussis by Month
