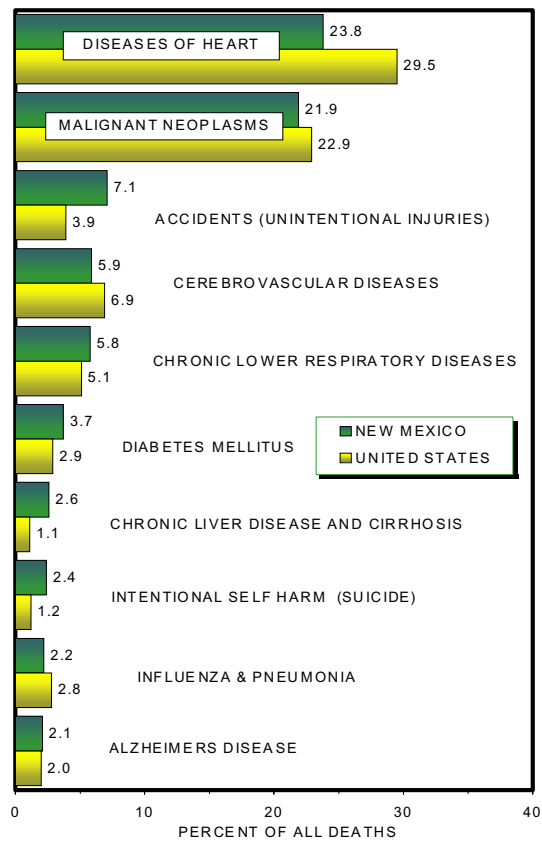
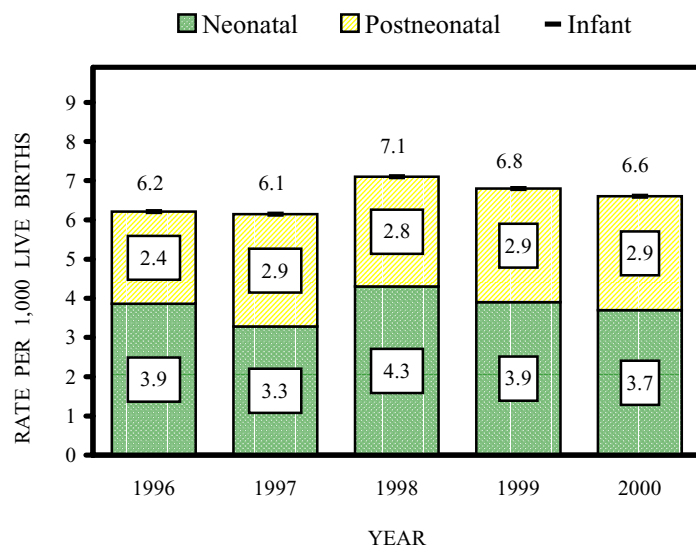


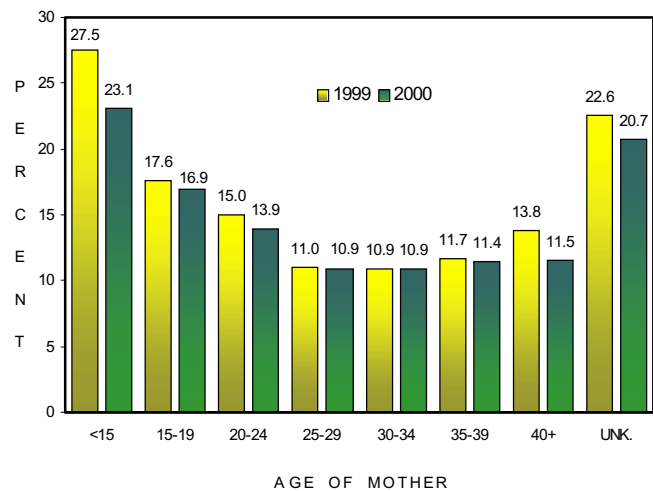

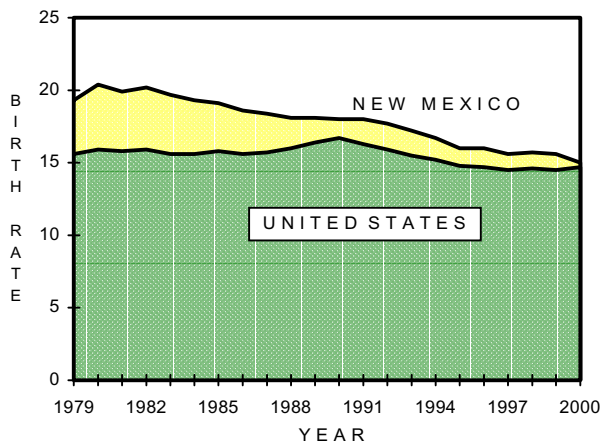
**INFANT, NEONATAL AND POSTNEONATAL
