

Affidavit for consent to amendment of vital record by Registrant 14 years of age or over

AMENDMENT OF LIVE BIRTH CERTIFICATES: This section is intended to supplement previous sections regarding the amendment live birth records (7.2.2.17)

To amend a birth certificate, application may be made by parents, the legal guardian, the registrant if 18 years of age or over, or the individual responsible for filing the certificate. On any request not made by the registrant him or herself for a child age fourteen years of age or older, the child must sign the application or give notarized consent to the change, and Section 17.D [now Subsection D of 7.2.2.17 NMAC] of these regulations applies.
