

## NM VFC Program – 2017 Provider Education Requirements

Primary and Backup Vaccine Coordinators are **required** to fulfill current educational requirements for the NM VFC Program:

- ✓ **Participating in an annual CHILI or CHIL-e**
- ✓ **Engaging in your VFC Compliance Visit** (every other year)

All staff responsible for storing and handling vaccines are strongly encouraged to take CHILI or CHIL-e and:

- ✓ **CDC “You Call The Shots” Web-Based Training Courses:**
  - **Vaccines for Children (VFC) – Jan. 2016**
  - **Vaccine Storage and Handling – Jan. 2016**
- ✓ **CDC video: “Keys to Storing and Handling Your Vaccine Supply”**

When you participate in a CHILI/CHIL-e and the web-based course “You Call The Shots” modules, you will be issued a certificate. You are required to keep certificates with your NM VFC paperwork and submit them to your Regional VFC Coordinator. Licensed nurses who wish to earn CNE after completing CHIL-e must submit their certificate to [sarah.meto@state.nm.us](mailto:sarah.meto@state.nm.us).

- ❖ You are now able to complete CHILI training online, “CHIL-e”. **If you are a new provider to the VFC program, you **must** contact your Regional VFC Coordinator regarding **ALL** trainings.** They will determine whether you will need an in-person or online CHILI training session.
