Narcan® Nasal Spray is covered with PA while being evaluated for formulary inclusion.	Naloxone injectable used with nasal atomizer. No plans to cover additional products at this time.	Naloxone injection is formulary and can be dispensed with the atomizer kit. Brand name Narcan nasal spray will be added to the formulary on 8/1/16.

C. Are there additional instructions for pharmacies in order to be adequately reimbursed?	Yes. The naloxone injection with the nasal inhaler (Naloxone Kit), an additional dispensing fee is applied to the claim. This product has been replaced by commercially available easy to administer formulations.	All information needed for pharmacies to be adequately reimbursed is included in the Coverage of Naloxone Rescue Kit Fax.	No, system is configured to pay \$40 professional fee.	When pharmacies dispense naloxone syringes and atomizer kits, they will need to bill for the administration fee. D. Are 3rd party prescriptions for naloxone covered; meaning can a member receive naloxone for someone they are concerned may overdose?	Yes, as long as the prescription meets federal prescribing requirements. The prescription would have to be written for and dispensed for the same member.	Yes, Naloxone prescriptions are covered. This naloxone may be utilized by another person to rescue the member and/or the member may utilize his/her own naloxone to rescue another person. Naloxone prescriptions are not covered in the name of those who are not members.	Yes, Naloxone is covered for PHP members. Claim needs to be submitted under PHP member's name.	Yes, but the pharmacy claim needs to be submitted with the insured member as the patient.
