The legal consequences of driving high

Driving under the influence of cannabis is **illegal and carries serious legal consequences** including fines, license suspension, and even imprisonment. Here are some rules you should know before you drive.

- You can use cannabis at home, but it is illegal to use it on the road or in a public space.
- Never drive or use heavy machinery while under the influence of cannabis.
- Patients enrolled in the Center for Medical Cannabis are allowed to drive with up to 425 units at any one time.
- It is **illegal to take cannabis** to airports, national parks, schools, government buildings, or federal courthouses.
- Transporting cannabis across state lines is illegal.
