If outpatient hearing screen is not available, **refer** baby immediately to an **audiologist** experienced in testing babies

**Immediately refer to NMSD** Early Intervention Program for children birth to age 6 who are deaf or hard of hearing at 1-800-841-6699

**Immediately refer** baby to ENT for medical clearance for hearing aids

**Mail or fax Report of Audiological Results** to Newborn Hearing Screening Program

**Discuss** additional Evaluations with **Parent** and **Refer** Baby as needed:
