

Information for Newcomers & Sponsors

The New Mexico Department of Health will assist Ukrainian newcomers and their sponsors with navigating health resources and coordinating health screenings.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Ukrainian or non Ukrainian individuals who last habitually resided in Ukraine
- Granted humanitarian parolee status by the Department of Homeland Security
- Paroled to the U.S. in 2022-2023

Services include:

- Tuberculosis testing
- Evaluation/treatment for tuberculosis, if needed
- Adult & pediatric immunizations
- Medical screening
- Services for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
- Referrals to primary care, dental, vision providers, and emotional wellness support
- Services available at no cost to the client. Russian and Ukrainian interpretation provided.
- Resettlement assistance, SNAP, case management, and other benefits may be available to eligible newcomers.
