- ❖ Voted to authorize the ICC Executive Committee to certify the Annual Performance Report (APR).
- ❖ Learned about the funding structure for the Family Infant Toddler (FIT) Program.
- ❖ Voted to add a standing ICC meeting agenda item on partnerships.
- ❖ Voted to table the voting on the *ICC Bylaws* until the April 2016 ICC meeting.
- ❖ Voted to accept changes to the *ICC Partnerships, Agreements and Commitments* document.
- ❖ Requested that the FIT Program review the ICC's recommendations regarding the ECO and email the ECO Rating Sheet to the FIT Coordinators List Serve as approved for use.
- ❖ Requested that the FIT Program reconsider the MEISER as one of FIT approved tools.
- ❖ Discussed and voted to approve ICC Committee Reports.
