- ❖ Learned about the statewide early intervention supports and services provided by the NM School for the Deaf Early Intervention and Involvement Division.
- ❖ Discussed the implications of SB 106 which is proposing to create a new early childhood services department and move all early childhood programs under this department.
- ❖ Voted to approve the formation of an ICC ad hoc committee that will meet with the sponsors of SB 106 and provide information and recommendations to the ICC.
- ❖ Learned about the proposed constitutional amendment to have early childhood programs receive a portion of the land grant permanent funds. Voted to recommend the FIT Program be included as a fund recipient.
- ❖ Voted to have the ICC Executive Committee review the completed the federal Annual Performance (APR) Report and have the ICC Co-Chairs sign the report.
- ❖ Discussed Children & Youth Day highlights.
- ❖ Voted to have Jim Copeland represent the ICC on the DOH Advisory Council of Quality Supports for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities and Their Families (ACQ).
- ❖ Voted to have Peggy O'Neill and Jim Copeland serve on the committee reviewing FIT Rate Study proposals.
- ❖ Voted to approve ICC Committee reports.
- ❖ Voted to accept the Lead Agency Report.
- ❖ Voted to accept revisions to ICC & DDSD/FIT Partnerships & Agreements.
