Updating Address Concerns

- If you receive social security benefits and need to update your address for your Income Support Division (ISD) case it is important that you contact the Social Security Administration for address updates in their system.
- You will then need to contact the Income Support Division to also update your address.
- If you do not update your address through the Social Security Administration your address update through ISD will keep returning to the address you have on file with the Social Security Administration.
- The Social Security Administration and ISD need to be contacted separately to update your address.

Knowing Your Paycheck

Have you wondered what the difference between gross pay and net pay is?

- **Gross pay** is the amount before taxes, or any other deductions are taken out of your pay.
- Net pay is your take-home pay and is after taxes and any other deductions are taken out. It is good to think of net pay as what you will take home to rely on financially.

Your federal and state taxes are determined by what you fill out on your W4. If you are not sure what deductions you filled out, it is good to complete a new W4 and submit to ensure it is accurate to your personal situation. It is good practice to complete a new W4 each year.

If you claim too many dependents on your W4 or have the incorrect filing status you may have either too many taxes taken out or not enough. When you file taxes at the end of the year this can create the need for you to pay back federal and state taxes. It is also good practice to always review deduction on your check to ensure everything looks correct. If you have opted for direct deposit, you always have the right to view your check stubs. Ask your employer for details.

What To Do When a Money Network Card (MNC) is Lost or Stolen

- Lock your MNC by logging in at <u>https://www.moneynetwork.com/</u> or via the Money Network Mobile App.
- Locking your card stops other people from using your MNC while you look for it.
- If your MNC is stolen, or hacked, report it to the police immediately.
- You will then call 888-913-0900 right away and tell them your MNC has been lost or stolen.
- They will freeze your MNC, while a new one is being sent.

Service Highlights:

Home health aide services:

- Home health aide services give total care or help participant in all activities of daily living to help improve quality of life and safe surroundings to support the participant's self-reliance and health needs in their home and in their community.
- Home health aide services can be provided in the participant's own home and outside the participant's home.
- Home health aide services do not duplicate homemaker services.
- Home health aide services may be provided long-term for the participant's habilitative support.
- Home health aides may provide basic non-invasive nursing assistant services within the range of their practice.
- Home health aides are supervised by a registered nurse (RN).
- Supervision by a RN will happen at least once every 60 calendar days in the participant's home.

Fun Easy Recipe

Raspberry Ice Cream in a Bag

Total time to make: 15 minutes

Makes 1 cup

Ingredients:

- 1 cup half-and-half cream
- 1/2 cup fresh raspberries
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons evaporated milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4 cups coarsely crushed ice
- 3/4 cup salt •

Directions:

- 1. Using two 1-quart resealable plastic bags.
- 2. Place 1 bag inside the other.
- 3. Place 1 cup half-and-half cream, 1/2 cup fresh raspberries, 1/4 cup sugar, 2 tablespoons evaporated milk, and 1 teaspoon vanilla extract inside the inner bag.
- 4. Seal both bags, pressing out as much air as possible.

5. Place the 2 bags in a gallon-size resealable plastic freezer bag.

- 6. Add ice and salt.
- 7. Seal bag, again pressing out as much air as possible.
- 8. Shake and knead cream mixture until thickened, about 5 minutes. (You can wear mittens or wrap bags in a kitchen towel while shaking to protect hands from the cold ice.)
