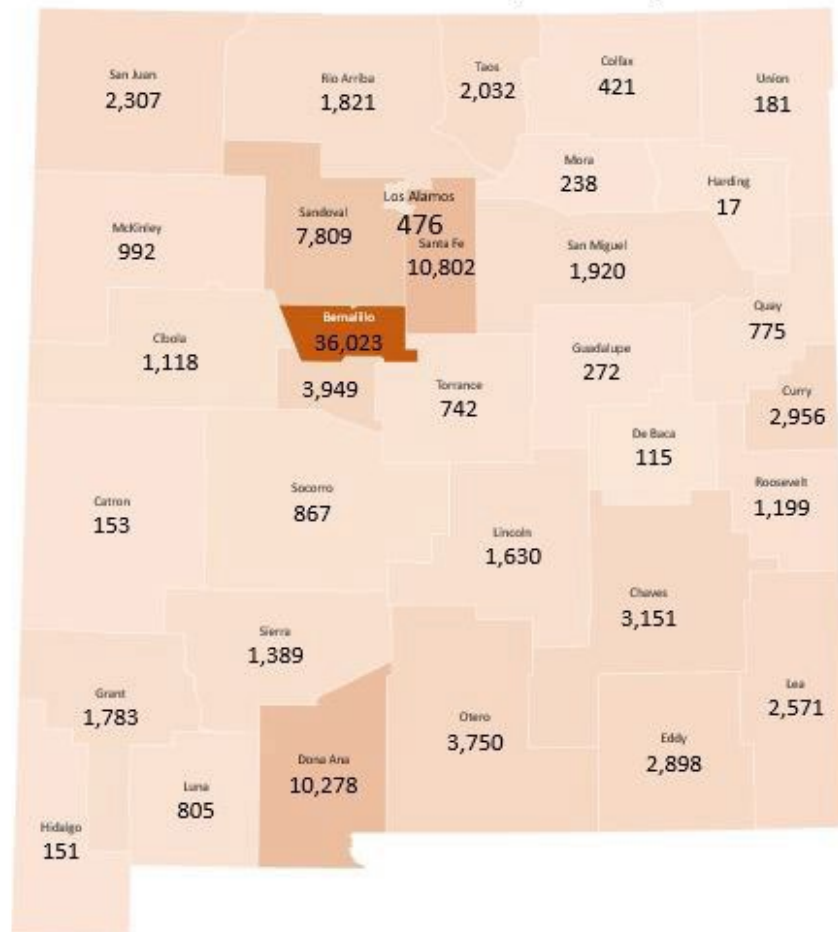

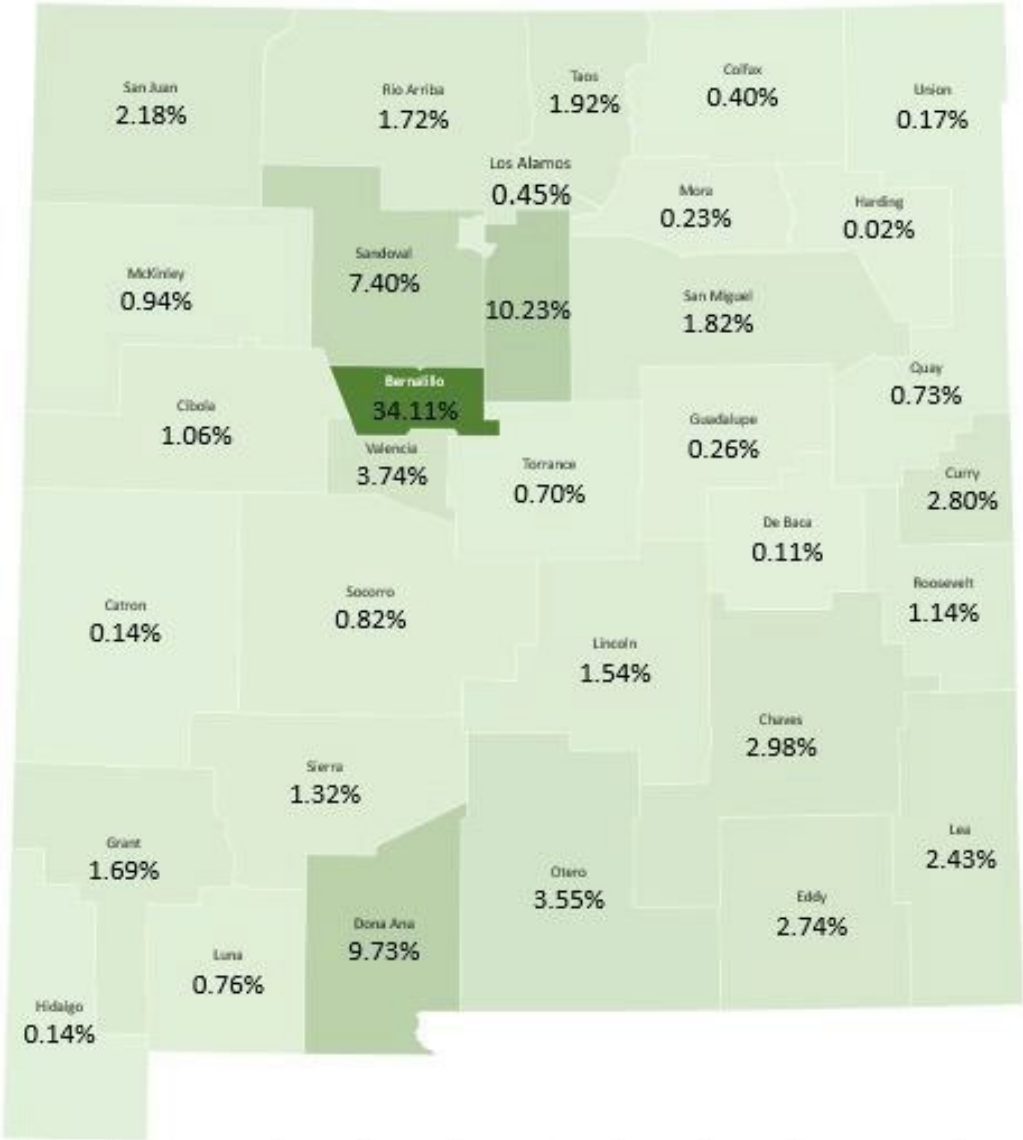

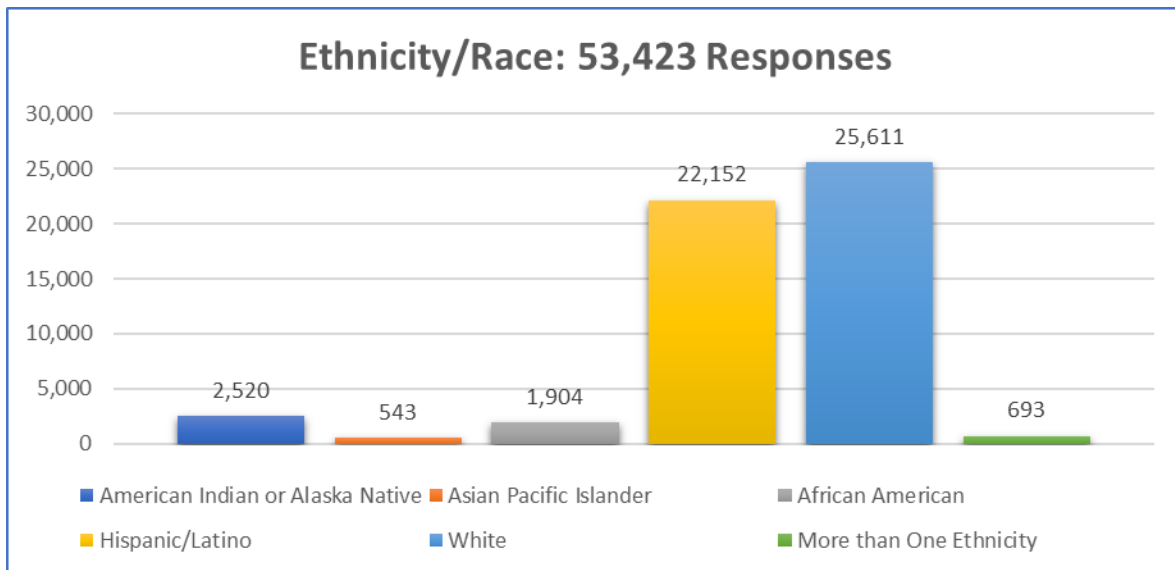

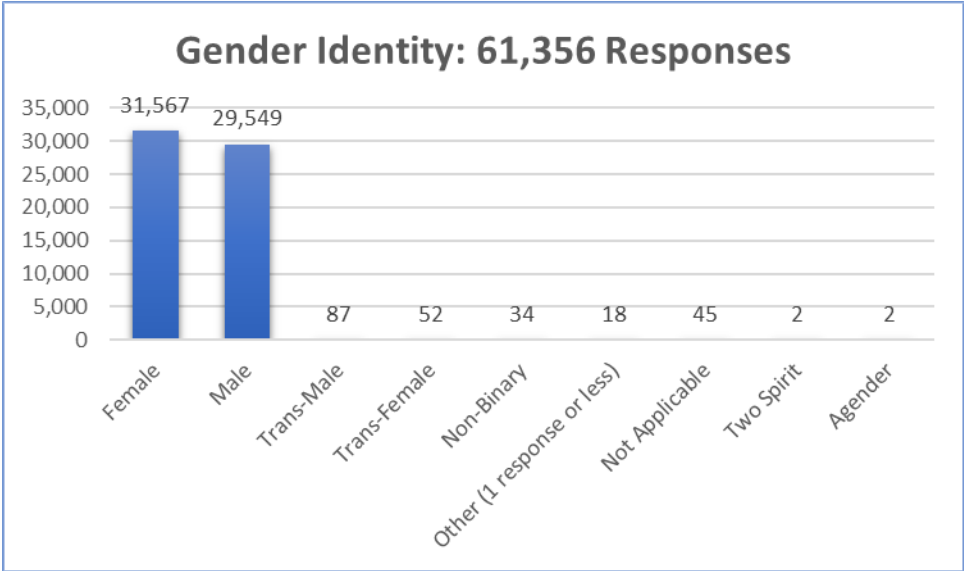

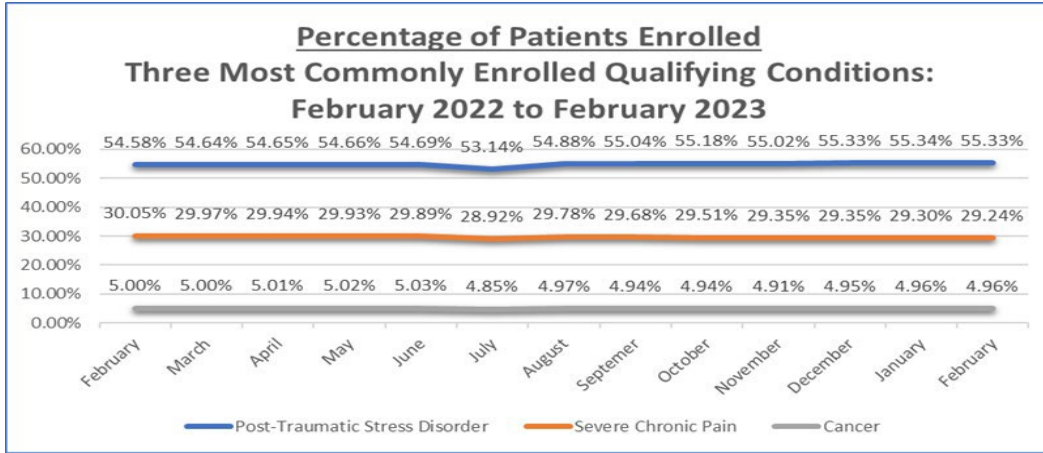
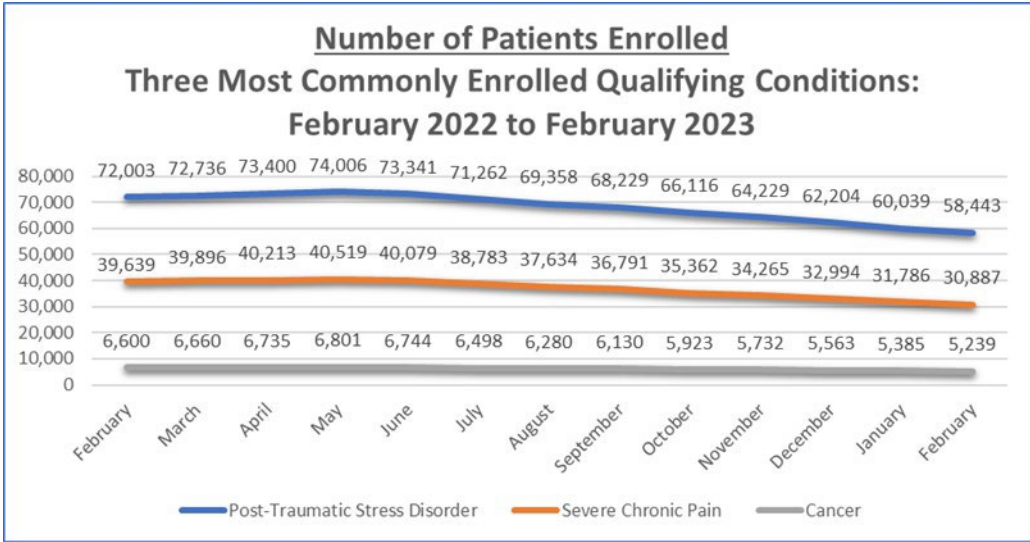
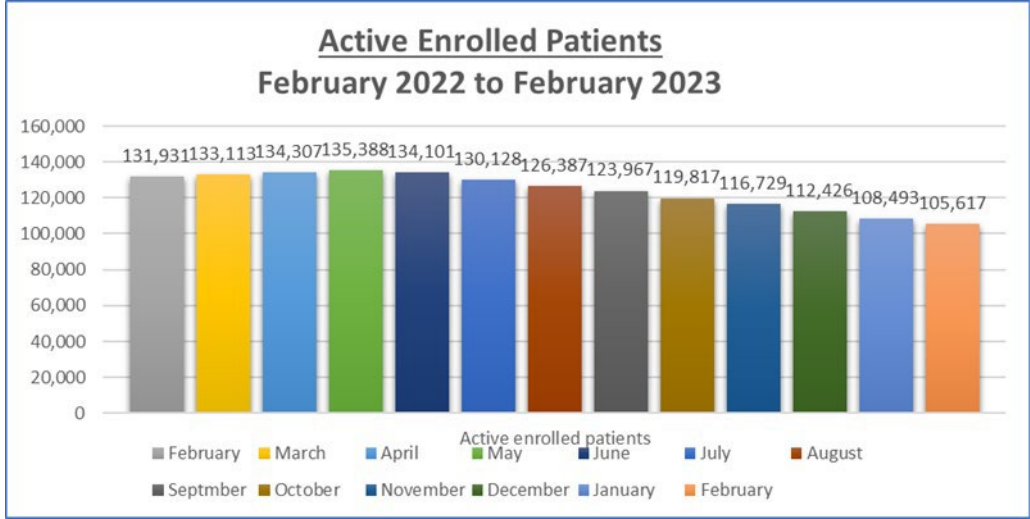


## Five-Year Enrollment Trends
